**Euston Farm** - Hi all and welcome to another update. We have started harvesting sugar beet and it's all going ok. I attended a grower meeting in July this year and they shared the news that we have got to look out for a Beet Moth! The beet moth turns into a caterpillar and attacks the crown of the sugar beet. I checked straight away and we had very little signs of the pest but now in November most fields are infected. It doesn't really affect the beet too much but there is crown damage and we will have to keep checking to make sure the caterpillar doesn't progress down into the sugar beet. In extreme cases the beet can be split in 2 pieces as the caterpillar bores further into the beet. Hedge cutting is underway so please be patient if he is temporarily in the way. Other jobs are firewood cutting and lots of workshop work. We had the proud job of building a Float for the Lord Mayors show in London on the 12th of November. The trailer was representing Red Tractor brand and also the NFU. Hopefully you all have a quiet and rested Christmas and we will see you in the new year. Matthew at Euston Farms.
