As per usual, Euston is basking in sun and desert like conditions. No rain for 5 weeks at a really crucial time for growth is very challenging. Thankfully after lots of praying from vicar Karen we did have 14mm in the last week of June which will certainly help the sugar beet and maize crops. Countryside week at school where the children see an element of agriculture and environmental practises has been happening this week. The farm has supported the school in all aspects from Marquees to tractors to sheep and vegetables. Many other farm visits have also been happening from the community and even Cambridge university alumni. Hay making next, to supply the winter food needed for all the cows and soon after that will be cereal harvest preparation. Corn storage sheds to be cleaned, field gateways to be mown so the tractor and trailer can see the ditches and then we are off harvesting mid-July. See you all soon, Matthew, Euston Farms.
