Euston Autumn Litter Pick - The Autumn litter pick will take place on Saturday, 15th October - could anyone willing to help please meet inside the park gates at 10.00am.

Euston Farm update. Hello all, at last we saw some rain! This was very welcome and well overdue. The Sugarbeet certainly responded very well and it also allowed us to get on with field preparation for next year. Maize harvest is around 50% complete and we will be chasing the harvester round drilling right behind it. A lot of the fields that are maize get drilled with a cereal next as normally it gives the ideal entry for winter barley and wheat. The Reservoirs are both empty and with the farm energy at 65.2p/kW we now review if we can afford to fill and then empty them in the summer of 2023. This is a huge blow for the farm and when the electricity was only 37p/kW we were still spending £50,000 per month at each pumping source so you can only imagine how things may be next season. The paulownia trees are growing well as I'm sure a lot of you have seen and now they are getting on top of all the weeds. They will hopefully have a good winter and come into the next year in good shape. I visited the former Barnham WI group of ladies and gentlemen last week with a little talk about all things at Euston. They people very interested in our school and community work and also me being dressed as a carrot every April! See you all soon, Matthew at Euston Farms.
