NEWS FROM EUSTON ESTATE Hello all and welcome to the Euston Farms update. This month is all about clearing crops that are currently in fields that need planting in the autumn. Potatoes, onions, parsnips, and maize are all in their harvest season. Please forgive us for any inconvenience that you may experience in this busy time. We do make all the practical modifications to the logistics that we can, but it is a very busy time non the less. Cereals will be starting to be planted as we come to the end of September and into October.

The sugar beet factory has opened already so we will soon start beet harvest too. Near the end of September, we have some VIPs coming to see us from British Sugar to learn all about the current issues with growing the crop and managing all the effects from its position in our rotation. From the moment Beet emerges there is something wanting to eat it or infect it and we are losing chemistry all the time in a climate of more attacks. We welcome everyone who asks to come and see us at the farm as this is the best platform to tell our story and make our issues understood.
