Our school swiftly changed overnight, as we focused on providing a daily place of care, stability, reassurance and support to our many key worker and vulnerable children. Alongside this, learning was set for our pupils at home, food parcels delivered, home visits carried out and telephone calls to families made to check our children and families were okay. I simply could not be prouder of our dedicated and compassionate staff team for rising to the many challenges during these unchartered times.

We have truly appreciated the treats from Barnham Bakers and prayers from the Blackbourne Ministry Team, along with surprise goodies hanging on the gate and of course, disposable gloves at a time that was very difficult to obtain them! All of these things have made an enormous difference to our team.

Hopefully by the time you read this our school community will be reunited again, albeit in class bubbles and with another comprehensive risk assessment and more safety measures in place, as we strive to keep our community as safe and reassured as possible. Whilst returning to a new normal with all children in school, engaged in irresistible learning.

One thing that has become apparent during the Covid19 pandemic is that even with the school stripped back and under enormous pressure, the heart of our school remains solid and strong, with the unwavering support of our community behind us.

Thank you for bearing with us over the summer weeks, we have had extensive and desperately needed repair works to the back of

the school and know at times these may have been a little noisy for some of the residents local to the school.

Barnham Village Hall - Re-opening after Lockdown: The Village Hall Committee have begun a phased and limited re-opening of the hall commencing Tuesday, 1st September 2020. This will follow the relevant guidelines provided by ACRE, (Action with Communities in Rural England) and requires the preparation and implementation of Supplementary Terms and Conditions for Hirers along with the relevant Risk Assessment(s). These are in preparation and will be available to Hirers and posted on the Barnham Village Hall website in due course – (see https://www.barnhamvillagehall.org/covid-19). Continuing restrictions still prohibit or limit certain events and Social Distancing and hygiene will remain priorities. As restrictions are further changed, the policy will be amended accordingly. In the first instance the Committee has contacted the regular Hirers to confirm long-standing arrangements but will also welcome new enquiries for private functions which would follow the relevant restrictions. At the time of writing, the Buzzy Bees Toddler Group and the Pilates Group have indicated that they will be restarting in September.
